ARGUMENT IN FAVOR


The current \$10 per parcel assessment for Rim of the World Recreation and Park District passed in 1983 and has not increased since then. This funding fails to meet the needs of our communities in 2010. Serving a growing population from Crestline to Green Valley Lake, and managing four multi-use ball fields, two senior/community centers, five licensed childcare sites and several playgrounds, Rim Park's role is critical to our quality of life.

Current funding is inadequate to provide improvements and continuation of programs. The proposed increase of \$1 per month is desperately needed to maintain facilities and programs including organized sports, recreation classes, licensed day care, senior centers and much more.

Our mountain communities' economic vitality benefits from parks and recreation related activities. Property values are higher in communities with well maintained parks. Since 2003, our park district has reinvested over \$1 million in the local economy by supporting local businesses. Engaging youth in creative and healthy activities is known to lower juvenile crime. Providing adults and seniors access to fitness, sports, activities and programs is essential to community health.

Your Park District is an "Independent Special District". This means your assessment comes directly back to our community with complete local control. Local residents elected by local voters sit on the Board, and are responsible for overseeing the District. If this measure fails, the District will face an unknown future including the possibility of closing its doors. The concern for everyone is the probable elimination of all recreational activities, programs and facilities at worse, or drastic reduction of these services and facilities at best.

The future of this Park District is in your hands. To ensure a sustainable future and retain quality recreational opportunities for all, Vote YES on Measure N! It is truly Now or Never.



ELECTIONS CODE
SECTION 9600
